**ORDER FINDING COMMERCIAL INSURANCE ALLIANCE IS INSOLVENT
AND SHORTENING CLAIMS FILING DEADLINE**


THIS CAUSE was considered on the Receiver's Motion for a Finding that Commercial Insurance Alliance is Insolvent and to Shorten Claims Filing Deadline. The Court having fully considered the matters set forth in the Motion, the Court hereby finds:

That Commercial Insurance Alliance ("CIA") is insolvent. Further, the Receiver may need to make an assessment in the CIA receivership estate. In order to accomplish this, the Receiver needs to determine what outstanding liabilities exist in relation to CIA. In order to reduce estate expenses and protect the interests of the policyholders, claimants and other creditors, it is best to determine the liabilities as soon as possible. As such, the deadline for filing claims should be shortened. Since this company has been in run off mode since August 2009, the shortened deadline should not hinder the ability of potential claimants to file a proof.

Therefore it is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that:

Commercial Insurance Alliance is insolvent. Further, the Receiver is authorized to shorten the claims filing deadline from 11:59 PM January 26, 2012, to 11:59 PM August 1, 2011.
