

MARTIN COUNTY CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT AUDIT FOLLOW-UP

Report No. 2022-85/March 9, 2022

BACKGROUND AND CONTEXT

The Department of Financial Services (DFS) has completed a follow-up review of the Martin County Clerk of the Circuit Court. The Department performed an audit of the Martin County Clerk of the Circuit Court in October 2017. The audit noted one (1) recommendation. A follow-up review was scheduled to review the implementation status of these recommendations.

OBJECTIVE AND SCOPE

The objective of the follow-up review was to determine the implementation status of prior audit observations and recommendations. The approach included interviews with staff members and an analysis of relevant files and supporting documentation.

The follow-up desk review covered County Fiscal Year (CFY) 20-21.

STATUS OF PRIOR AUDIT OBSERVATIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS

Our review concluded that 100% of the recommendations noted in Report No. 2017-18 were implemented.

The summary of the audit recommendation status is as follows:

#	SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATION	STATUS
1.	• We recommend the Clerk's office ensure that its court-related expenditures are allowable according to sections 28.35(3)(a), Florida Statues (F.S.) We also recommend that the Clerk's office reimburse the State for the expenditures totaling \$539, since the Clerk's office received funds from the Clerks of Court Trust Fund in CFY 14-15 only.	Drinking water is no longer allocated to the court. Registration fees follow the allocation methodology utilized in budgeting for the individual employee's department. The status of this recommendation is complete.

We recommend the Clerk's office ensure that its court-related expenditures are

Phone minutes as well as phone accessories are no longer charged to the court. The Clerk's allowable according to s 29.008(1)(f)1, F.S. office stated that the office had taken steps to ensure proper coding of court expenditures including identifying the staff members who benefited from the expenditure. There has been additional training and implementation procedures for monthly review for proper account coding controls to maintain compliance with s 29.008(1)(f)1, F.S. The status of this recommendation is complete.
