- General Ledger Structure (Chart of Accounts) and Values
- No Certified Forward Indicator (CFI) – using Budget Date
- No more dividing transactions! We will be using the Allocation Function in Works. 😊
- Travel vs Non-Travel
- Updated Errors for Florida PALM
- Merchant information will come from VISA. It will no longer be a GL segment.

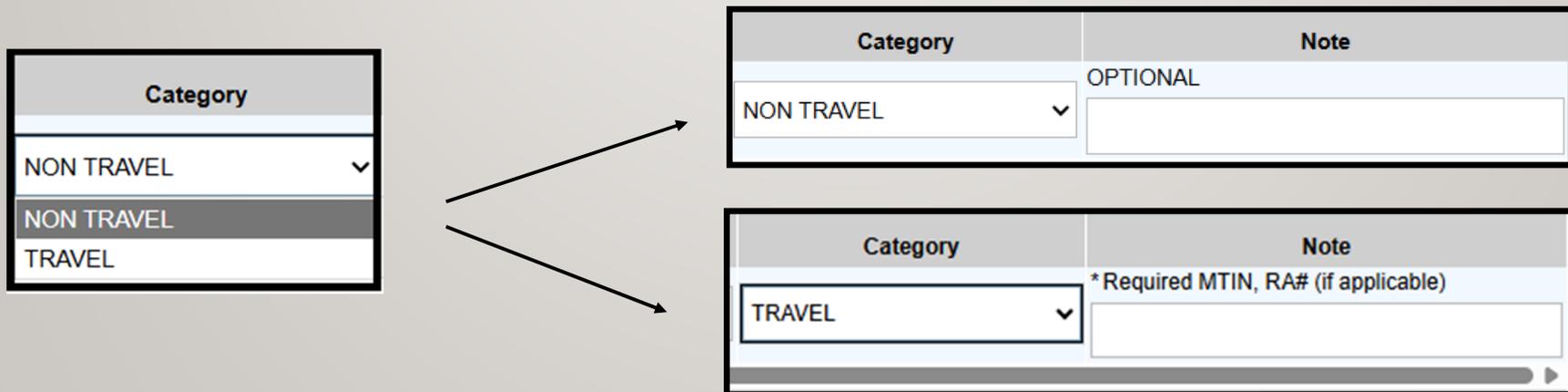


BENEFITS TO ALLOCATING

- Enhanced functionality with Florida PALM
- User friendly with less processing time
- Combined processing of allocated lines! 😊
- Flexibility of adding and deleting lines
- Error handling, reporting and reconciliation made easy

TRAVEL VS. NON-TRAVEL

- Currently the State of Florida places the Master Trip Invoice Number (MTIN) on the transaction in Works.
- Category field requires user to select travel or non-travel.



ERROR HANDLING

A Transactional Error is an error that occurs on the transaction level and needs to be corrected by the agency. This would typically be the accountant.

Fatal Errors will be handled by DFS.

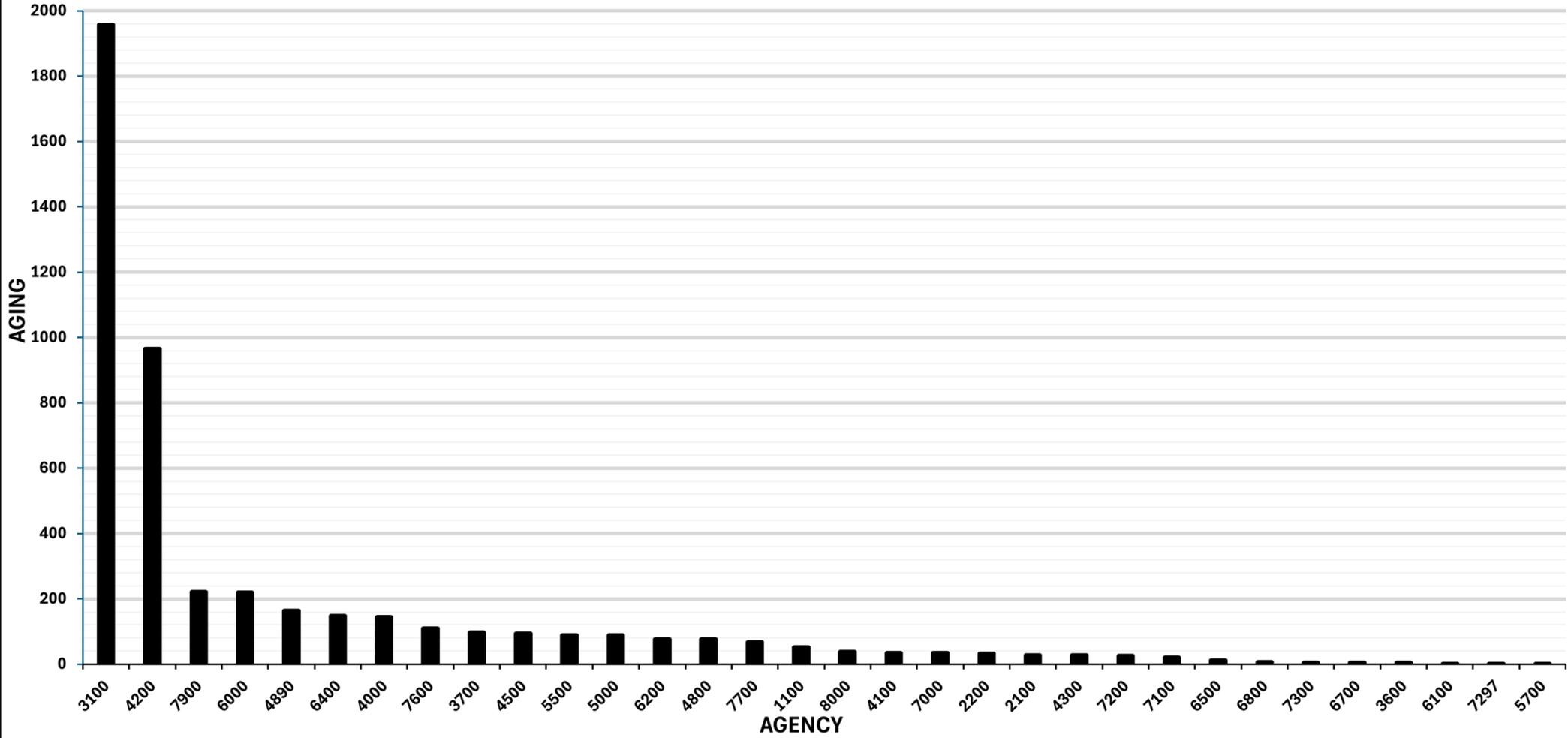


CLEARING CHARGES

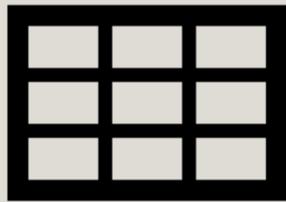
Why?

FAQ

- **Will SpeedKeys** be required for Works? **Yes!** Works requires the use of single-line SpeedKeys for providing the Fund, Budget Entity, Category, and State Program Component with each PCard transaction. Each SpeedKey set is like setting up a shortcut to ensure coding is complete and valid.
- **How is** Works going to update SpeedKeys? Florida PALM will send new and updated SpeedKeys to Works each day, ensuring the system always reflects the most current accounting values.
- **How will SpeedKeys** be defaulted to users and/or groups? Works will receive SpeedKeys for default allocation through configuration workbooks loaded during implementation. After go-live, defaults can be modified in the user and group settings in Works.
- Are the OA1 and OA2 fields optional? **Yes!**
- Will the description and notes fields still be available? **Yes!**
- Will there be a Vendor ID field in Works? **No,** Works will collect and transfer the merchant information passed from the TSYS system.
- When will Works switch from FLAIR processing to Florida PALM processing? **Information regarding the conversion period is forthcoming.**
