CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER MEMORANDUM NO. 26

SUBJECT: ADMINISTRATIVE HEALTH INSURANCE ASSESSMENT

Senate Bill (SB) 2500, the Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-2026 General Appropriations Act, and SB 2502, Implementing the FY 2025-2026 General Appropriations Act, requires the Department of Management Services (DMS) to assess an Administrative Health Insurance Assessment (AHIA) to each state agency. In addition, these laws require the Chief Financial Officer to transfer to DMS any assessment that is more than 60 days delinquent.

To comply with this requirement, the Division of Accounting and Auditing, Bureau of State Payrolls, upon receiving certification from DMS that an assessment is more than 60 days delinquent, will make the transfer to DMS from an agency fund authorized for payroll disbursements and which has adequate cash and budget to make the transfer. Agencies will be responsible for recording the disbursement in Departmental Florida Accounting Information Resource (FLAIR) and reallocating the expenditures to the appropriate funds.
