**CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER MEMORANDUM NO. 30**

**SUBJECT:     ADVANCING ACCOUNTABILITY REQUIREMENTS**

Section (s.) 287.057(15)(a)(b)(c), Florida Statutes (F.S.) charges the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) with providing training for accountability in contracts and grant management to contract managers responsible for contracts over Category 2, as defined in s. 287.017, F.S. The CFO meets this requirement through its Advancing Accountability for State Agencies training program which highlights contract management performance monitoring requirements, best practices, payment, and invoice requirements. Contract Managers are required to complete this training every five years along with the Florida Certified Contract Managers (FCCM) training to comply with state law. Currently this course is for state agency personnel only.

For non-state agency staff such as universities, municipalities, counties, etc., there is the Advancing Accountability for Recipients and Subrecipients (Providers) - Best Practices in Contracts and Grants Management course that gives guidance for compliance. While recommended, this training for non-state agency staff is not required.
