WHEREAS, International Firefighters Day is celebrated on May 4th because it is Saint Florian's Day, who was the first commanding firefighter of an actual Roman battalion saving many lives and is considered the patron saint of firefighters; and

WHEREAS, International Firefighters Day is a time where the world's community can recognize and honor the sacrifices that firefighters make to ensure that their communities and environment are safe as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer and State Fire Marshal of the State of Florida does hereby recognize May 4th as

INTERNATIONAL FIREFIGHTERS DAY

and encourage all citizens to outwardly thank and show their appreciation to firefighters who dedicate their lives to protect life and property to all Floridians.
