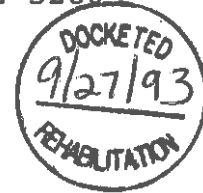

ORDER AUTHORIZING DISTRIBUTION


ORDERED and ADJUDGED as follows:
