Use of Estimates:

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with the Annual Statement Instructions and Accounting Practices and Procedures Manual requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Actual results could differ significantly from those estimates.

Unearned Premium Reserves:

Premiums are earned over the terms of the related insurance policies. Unearned premium reserves are established to cover the unexpired portion of premiums written.

Policy Acquisition Expenses:

Expenses incurred in connection with acquiring new insurance business, including acquisition costs such as sales commissions, are charged to expense as incurred.

Premium Deficiency Calculations:

The Company anticipates investment income as a factor in the premium deficiency calculation.

Unpaid Losses and Loss Adjustment Expenses:

Unpaid losses and loss adjustment expenses consist entirely of amounts incurred but not reported. Such liabilities are necessarily based on assumptions and estimates, and while management believes the amounts are adequate, the ultimate liability may be in excess or less than the amount provided.

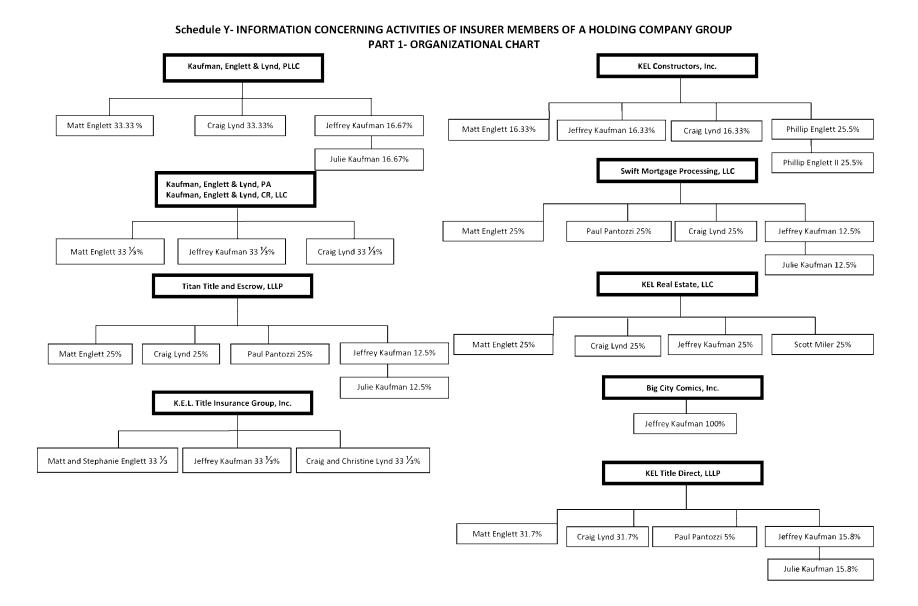
