Task Overview

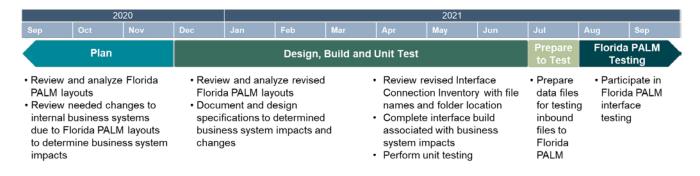
The purpose of this task is to provide agencies with information to support their internal design, build, and unit test of interfaces to Florida PALM. Based on the response you provided in the Interface Connection Inventory (TECH85), you have identified internal processes and business systems that will rely on Central Wave Florida PALM data.

To support your design activities, we will provide:

- Central Wave Interface Office Hours held in November 2020 (TECH92) and late January March 2021 (TECH97);
- Revised Interface Layouts based on agency feedback through April 2021 (TECH84); and
- Updated Interface Connection Inventory based on agency feedback in May 2021.

You are encouraged to collaborate with your agency's subject matter experts and Change Champion Network (CCN) to define your agency's activities to plan, design, build, and test your interfaces. We recommend creating a project plan to track agency-specific interface tasks, dates, and milestones.

As part of the preparation for interface testing planned to start in August 2021, the Project recommends completing the following activities:



Readiness Coordinators will check on the status of your design, build, and unit test tasks in Readiness Touchpoint meetings over the upcoming months. Agencies will **not** be asked to provide design, build, and unit test documentation to Florida PALM.
