2022 IMPLEMENTATION OVERVIEW

While activities are well under way for the CMS Wave, preparation has begun for the Central Wave implementation. All agencies will transition to Florida PALM in July 2022 for functions currently conducted using Central FLAIR.

HOW WILL THIS AFFECT AGENCIES?

Central FLAIR functionality will transition to Florida PALM. At the Central Wave implementation, end users can expect to complete the following activities in Florida PALM, such as:

- Request transactional funds (i.e. local funds and a further breakdown of budgetary funds) using Automated Fund Questionnaire
- Create Investment journal entries
- Monitor Appropriations, Release, and Reserves
- Monitor Fund Cash Balances
- Perform Budget and Cash Checking
- Manage Budget, Cash, and Transaction Exceptions
- Generate GR Service Charge Report
- View posted Vouchers

HOW DO AGENCIES PREPARE?

Agencies will be asked to participate in readiness tasks which may include:

Prepare People:

- Evaluate participation in and effectiveness of your Change Champion Network.
- Communicate regularly about Project activities and your internal process changes.
- Participate in workshops, meetings, and trainings.
- Engage end users about upcoming Central Wave changes.
- Determine resources needs and submit appropriate Legislative Budget Request(s).

Align Processes:

- Identify Chart of Account impacts to business systems and operating processes.
- Review and identify changes resulting from the Central Wave business processes, including reporting.
- Update internal documentation based on the impacts of Central Wave functionality.

Enable Technology:

- Identify changes needed for interfaces and business systems for the Central Wave.
- Design, build, and test identified interfaces for Central Wave.
- Retire business system(s) that duplicate Florida PALM Central Wave functionality.
- Cleanse data in preparation for Central Wave data conversions.
