Employee Self-Service Access

- Replaces <u>EIC website</u> at go-live.
- ALL employees must create a new UserID and Password.
- Allows employees to maintain his or her W-4, Direct Deposit* information, consent to electronic W-2*, as well as view paystubs, employee reimbursements, and other employee payment related information.
- W-4 and Direct Deposit information will be loaded on users behalf at go-live but W-2 consent must be re-elected.
- Requires multifactor authentication login that is different from Florida PALM.
- Accessible 4 years after employment separation.

*Activities will NO LONGER be performed in People First at go-live
