



Readiness Criteria: Update 1 – Begin UAT and Interface Testing

Agencies will provide the first update to Agency Readiness Certification in July 2025 (RW Task 593) to indicate they are ready to begin participating in User Acceptance Testing (UAT) and Cycle 2 – Technical Interface Testing. Readiness criteria for this certification update is provided in Table 1.

Readiness Criteria: Update 2 – Continue UAT and Prepare for Full Integration Testing

Agencies will provide the second update to Agency Readiness Certification in November 2025 (RW Task 606) to indicate they are ready to continue UAT and are prepared to soon begin agency-led sessions for agency end users and fully integrated UAT to test end to end processes, including agency business systems and enterprise systems. Readiness Criteria: Final – Ready to Go-Live

Final submission of the Agency Readiness Certification will occur in May 2026 (RW Task 628), indicating the culmination of all testing activities and that the agency is ready to go-live. This final submission of Agency Readiness Certification will be provided to the ESC for review and consideration as they prepare to vote on Stage Gate 5: Agency Readiness.

Readiness criteria for the certification submission is provided in Table 4. Some tasks required for go-live will be completed after the Submission of Agency Readiness Certification in mid-May. Those tasks are identified with an asterisk in the table below and indicate the criteria minimum for the final submission.
