PCR Need Description <i>(Include description of change, why it is needed, how it was discovered)</i>	<p>After execution of Amendment 8 and as a result of payroll solution design conversations, the Department of Financial Services (DFS) has requested the following changes to Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements and Attachment 5.2 – Customizations.</p> <p><u>Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Request to cancel the following requirement associated to the GR Revenue Refunds (C66) customization requesting to be cancelled in the Attachment 5.2 – Customizations section below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 60.1003 – Provide the ability for all agencies to perform general revenue refunds using DFS COA values and appropriation. Request to modify the following requirement and update the How Met to “Extension” to be associated to the High Volume Bank Reconciliation (C68) customization which is requesting to be modified in the Attachment 5.2 – Customizations section below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 30.0299 (Current) – Provide ability to produce a warrant for EFT returns, including creation of a remittance advice and update of the payment data to indicate payment by warrant instead of EFT. 30.0299 (Revised) – Provide ability to systematically cancel a returned ACH payment and close the voucher, or cancel and reissue the returned ACH Payment as a warrant, to include creation of a remittance advice and inactivation of the supplier ACH Location, as applicable. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 40.1002 (New) – Provide the ability to record the actual date an asset is scanned when performing asset physical inventory activities. <p>5) Request to add the following requirement to support the addition of the Child Support Garnishment Banking Information (C129) customization requested in the Attachment 5.2 – Customizations section below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 200.1122 (New) - Provide the ability to establish State Disbursement Unit (SDU) banking information at the employee level by selecting from SDU banking configuration. <p>6) Request to add the following requirement to support the addition of the Writ of Garnishment Holding and Releasing Payments (C130) customization requested in the Attachment 5.2 – Customizations section below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 200.1123 (New) – Provide the ability to specify when Writs of Garnishment can be released for payment using release functionality. <p><u>Attachment 5.2 – Customizations:</u></p> <p>1) Request to cancel the GR Revenue Refunds (C66) customization. This customization was to provide the ability to enforce processing of GR Revenue Refund vouchers (only) that would allow agencies to apply the appropriate DFS ChartField coding. (Credit \$104,973)</p> <p>The GR Revenue Refund process requires agencies to refund overpayments by recording a voucher using DFS non-operating budget authority COA. The Project team along with A&A evaluated the following two customization options to address C66; 1) require agencies to provide their GR revenue refunds to A&A to create AP vouchers on behalf of agencies using the Inbound Voucher Spreadsheet Upload (API041), or 2) establish a new AP and GL business unit designated as 4300X for the sole purpose of entering GR Revenue Refunds. Pros and cons were discussed with both options and it was determined that neither option would be viable for the solution. A solution that does not require a customization will be implemented that does not require agencies to use A&A appropriation.</p> <p>The Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements that are being cancelled related to the C66 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 60.1003 – Provide the ability for all agencies to perform general revenue refunds using DFS COA values and appropriation. <p>2) Request to modify the High Volume Bank Reconciliation (C68) customization. This modification provides the ability to manage high volume bank reconciliation updates needed for ACH payment return processing without updating bank reconciliation items one by one. Enhanced functionality will be implemented to systematically cancel a returned ACH payment and close the associated voucher or cancel and reissue the returned ACH payment as a warrant, to include inactivating the supplier ACH location to prevent future ACH payments from being made to a supplier, as applicable. (Cost \$72,509)</p> <p>As delivered, when an ACH payment is returned by the bank, and it will not be reissued as a warrant or a new payment will not be generated, the returned payment must be manually unreconciled to subsequently allow a user to cancel and close the voucher. As delivered, there is no automated process to systematically cancel and reissue the payment.</p> <p>As a result of the enhanced functionality being requested, the customization title is requested to be revised from/to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High Volume Bank Reconciliation (Current) • Automated ACH Returns Processing (Revised) <p>The Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements being modified related to the C68 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:</p>
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 30.0299 (Revised) – Provide ability to systematically cancel a returned ACH payment and close the associated voucher, or cancel and reissue an ACH returned payment as a warrant, to include creation of a remittance advice and inactivation of the supplier ACH Location, as applicable. <p>3) Request to cancel the Available Balance Dashboard (C81) customization. This customization would provide a dashboard that displays available balances for appropriations, releases, reserves, allotments, encumbrances, expenditures, cash and revenue, as well as display actuals vs. budget variance information by Chart of Account code combinations. (Credit \$145,410)</p> <p>The customization is requesting to be cancelled as Oracle will provide dashboard functionality in a future release that would render the C81 customization obsolete. Implementing the customization based on the current release functionality planned for the Financials Wave go-live would not provide the preferred solution that the future release capabilities will provide.</p> <p>Instead, Florida PALM will leverage the existing Budget Overview page that provides agencies the ability to inquire and report on available balances for appropriations, releases, reserves, allotments, encumbrances, expenditures, cash and revenue, one ledger at a time. In addition, the GR Cash Balance and Activity Report (GLR079) and the Trust Fund Cash Balance and Activity Report (KKR059) will also be designed and built to provide additional cash balance reporting.</p> <p>The Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements requested to be revised or moved to Optional Services that are related to the C81 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10.0359 – Provide ability to produce budgeted as compared to actuals reports for Chart of Accounts codes combinations (e.g., appropriation, agency operating, and multiple grant/project budget structures). • 20.0141 – Provide online dashboard that displays available budget ledger balances by Chart of Account code combinations selected by end users. At a minimum, this will include: appropriations, releases, reserves, allotments, encumbrances, expenditures, cash, and revenue. • 80.0023 (Revised) – Provide the ability to display a cash position by BU and Fund from the Spendable Cash Ledger and associated modules that displays: spendable cash, deposits, scheduled AP payments, Inter/IntraUnit and GL transactions not successfully cash checked. • 80.0074 – Provide daily cash balance by grant. <p>4) Request to modify the Payroll Redistributions (C122) customization to decrease the scope. The current scope allows agencies to select and process payroll redistributions from transactions posted to the Financials HR Accounting Line within the Inter/IntraUnit solution.</p> <p>The customization is requesting to be modified to remove the capabilities for agencies to select transactions recorded on the Financials HR Accounting Line to process payroll redistributions. Instead, agencies will enter payroll redistributions directly within the InterUnit module without selecting transactions recorded on the Financials HR Accounting Line to be redistributed. Once payroll redistributions are posted, the customization will record the accounting entries on the Financials HR Accounting Line. (Credit \$34,441)</p> <p>The existing Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C122 customization is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 100.0544 – Provide the ability to redistribute payroll accounting entries as IntraUnit transactions that are posted to the General Ledger (GL) and Financials HR Accounting Line. <p>5) Request to add new Asset Physical Inventory Scan Date (C128) customization. This customization would provide the ability to define and load a unique asset scan date as provided by agencies within the Inbound Asset Physical Inventory File loaded into Florida PALM. (Cost \$19,224)</p> <p>As delivered, once agencies physically inventory their assets, they will load the inventory details via</p>
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	<p>the Inbound Asset Physical Inventory File to reconcile against the assets recorded in Florida PALM. The program that loads the file assigns the same scan date to all assets in the file with the current program run date and time, preventing the ability to designate a unique scan date for each asset.</p> <p>The new Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C128 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 40.1002 (New) – Provide the ability to record the actual date an asset is scanned when performing asset physical inventory activities. <p>6) Request to add new Child Support Garnishment Banking Information (C129). This customization will allow EFT Child Support Information to be configured by the State Disbursement Unit (SDU) and allow BOSP to select a State value in the State field which will pull in the banking information for the respective State to establish the EFT record on a Child Support garnishment record. (Cost \$35,859)</p> <p>As delivered, SDU information must be entered individually each time a Child Support garnishment order is setup for an employee. This customization allows the SDU Banking information to be established as a configuration and then when the Child Support order is entered, BOSP will only need to select the State value and the banking information will automatically populate.</p> <p>The new Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C129 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 200.1122 (New) - Provide the ability to establish State Disbursement Unit (SDU) banking information at the employee level by selecting from SDU banking configuration. <p>7) Request to add new Writ of Garnishment Holding and Releasing Payments (C130) customization. This customization will allow Writ of Garnishments to be held until the Final Order is received and the payment should be released. (Cost \$43,401)</p> <p>As delivered Garnishment Payments are released if there is a supplier established on the garnishment and the payments are released at the completion of each payroll cycle when the employee has a garnishment deduction. This customization allows the supplier to be entered once it is known and allows BOSP to release the payment for all deductions that have been withheld from the employee's paycheck and send the information to AP for payment by running the extract process a single time once the release has been entered.</p> <p>The new Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements related to the C130 customization, as noted in the Attachment 5.1 – Business Requirements section above, is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 200.1123 (New) – Provide the ability to specify when Writs of Garnishment can be released for payment using release functionality.
<p>Business Benefit/Justification <i>(Provide the tangible/intangible value(s) that support the Project's goals)</i></p>	<p>The requested requirement and customizations additions and changes enable Florida PALM to design the appropriate solution, meeting the requirements for the Financials and Payroll Wave.</p>
<p>Implications of Not Making the Change <i>(If we do nothing, what is our "Impact Prediction" to the project in terms of risk or issue)</i></p>	<p>The desired solution design and business requirements would not be met by delivered Florida PALM functionality. Failure to implement or update the requested customizations would result in the following implications:</p> <p>Cancellation of GR Revenue Refunds (C66):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Without this change a customization would be built that would not be utilized. <p>Modification of High Volume Bank Reconciliation (C68):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Without the additional customization, A&A would manually cancel and close the returned ACH payments as well as inactivate the supplier ACH Location, as applicable, which would increase their workload. Agencies would enter new vouchers to reissue applicable payments as a

	<p>warrant, which would be inefficient given Florida PALM's payment reissue functionality and could delay payment to the payee. Additionally, delays in A&A cancelling the ACH return payment could cause cash to be held up, impacting other AP payments from successfully cash checking.</p> <p>Cancellation of Available Balance Dashboard (C81):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Failure to cancel would result in implementing a temporary dashboard solution that does not meet the desired visualization and functionality requirements, resulting in wasted effort and re-work once Florida PALM is upgraded to the applicable later release. <p>Modification of Payroll Redistributions (C122):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Without modifying this customization, the original customization would be implemented, adding complexities to the IntraUnit solution. <p>Addition of Asset Physical Inventory Scan Date (C128):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Without this customization, the scan date on inventoried assets loaded through the Inbound Asset Physical Inventory File interface would be defined as the program load date vs. the actual asset scan date, providing inaccurate inventory information. <p>Addition of Child Support Garnishment Banking Information (C129):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Without this customization, Child Support SDU banking information would need to be entered each time a Child Support Order is setup for an employee that is paid via SDU ACH. <p>Addition of Writ of Garnishment Holding and Releasing Payments (C130)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Without this customization, Garnishment payments would be sent to AP for payment at the conclusion of each payroll if the Writ of Garnishment supplier is known. If the supplier is not known when the Writ of Garnishment is established a manual process would have to be put in place to pay the supplier. As delivered, the AP process extracts payments at the completion of each payroll cycle.
