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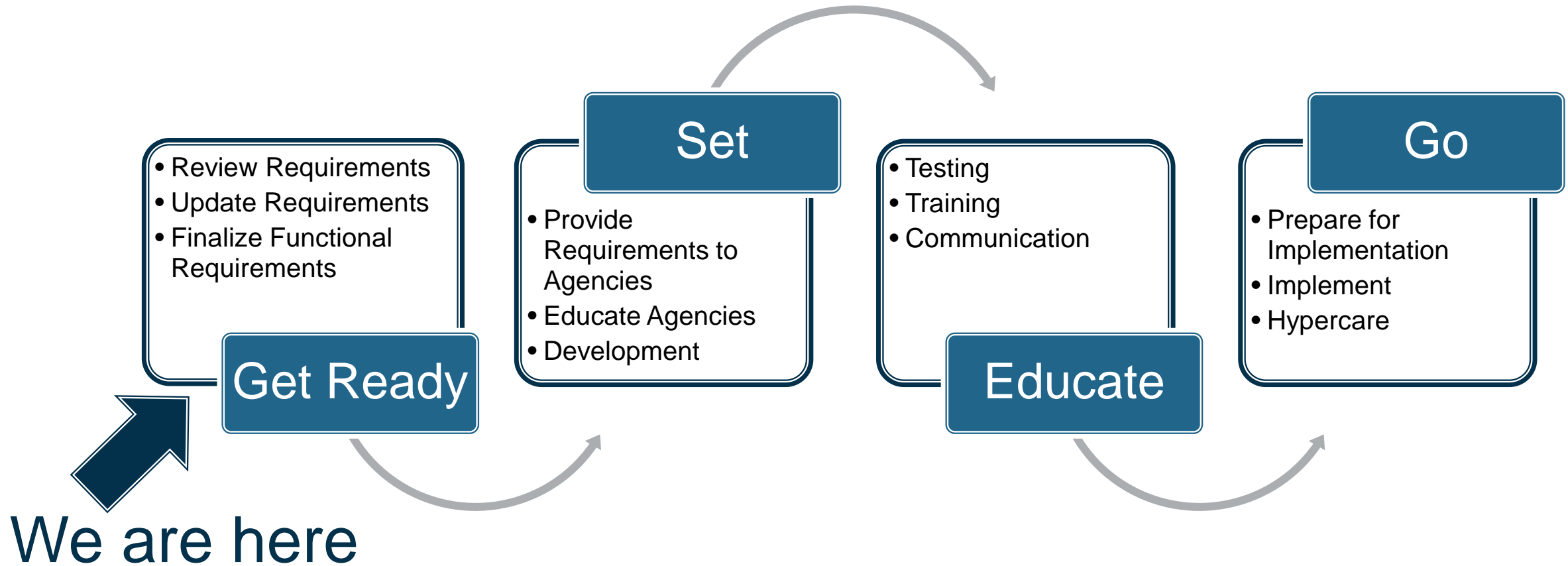

Information Warehouse Assessment

- ▶ Data Warehouse & Business Intelligence Solution
 - Replace Information Warehouse
 - Implementation to be concurrent with Financials and Payroll Waves
 - Self-service functionality
 - Standard reports
 - Ad-hoc reports & data extracts
 - Historical reporting
 - Business intelligence tools
- ▶ Gartner report published November 2022
 - Recommendation to use Oracle Data Warehouse with Oracle Business Intelligence Tool

Project Update

Personalized Agency Working Sessions

COMMONALITIES

- ▶ Scripting of transactions into FLAIR
- ▶ Extensive reliance on EOs, Grouping Characters, Site Codes
- ▶ Reliance on revenue object codes for tracking and reporting
- ▶ Multi-year fiscal data need
- ▶ User-friendly data query tool
- ▶ Creative, sometimes one-off accounting techniques for atypical tracking or reporting needs
- ▶ Tracking service or receipt date
- ▶ Life-to-date data need for grants
- ▶ Business rules built around GL and or Object Code
- ▶ Non-standard FLAIR data elements used for capturing reporting needs
- ▶ External asset management system or process
- ▶ Adoption of electronic document retention and routing processes outside of FLAIR

- ▶ Retire or remediate Agency Business Systems

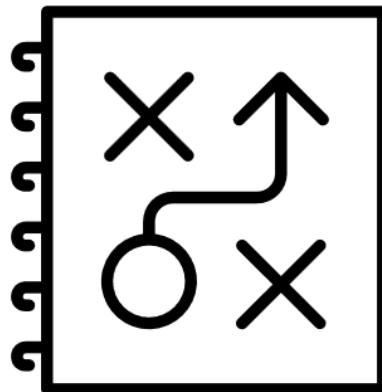

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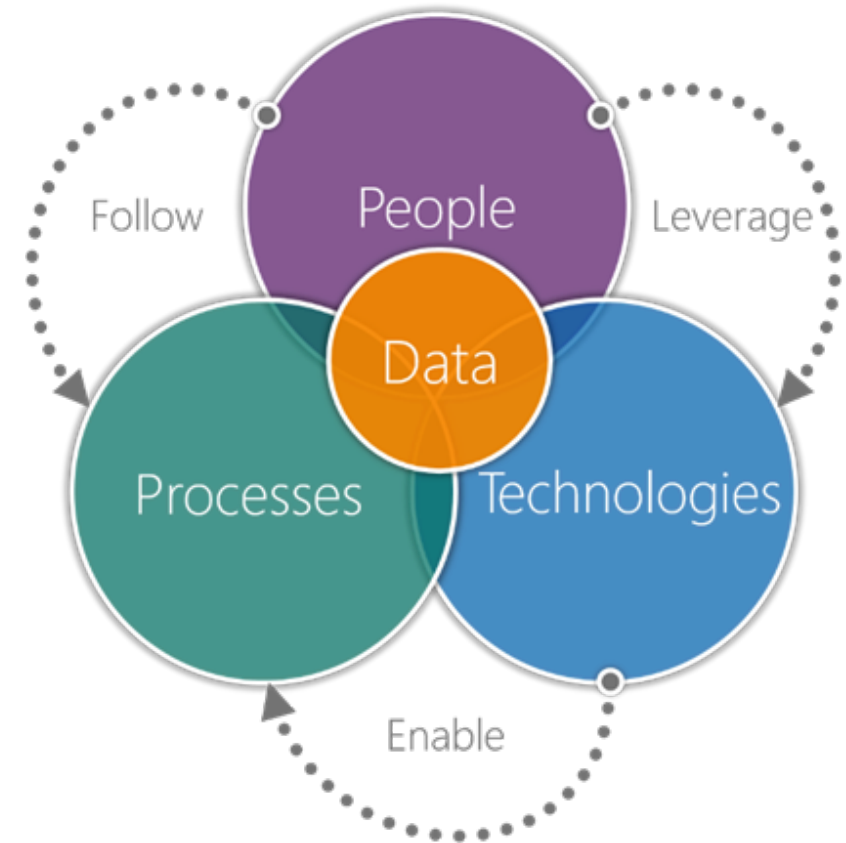

Agency Current State Analysis

RW Tasks Overview

- ▶ As we move into Design, RW Tasks are designed to guide an “as is” (current state) analysis of an agency’s four core components:
 - *People* – Users and stakeholders
 - *Processes* – Controls and outcomes
 - *Technologies* – Digital tools and resources
 - *Data* – Operational and historical



Agency Current State Analysis

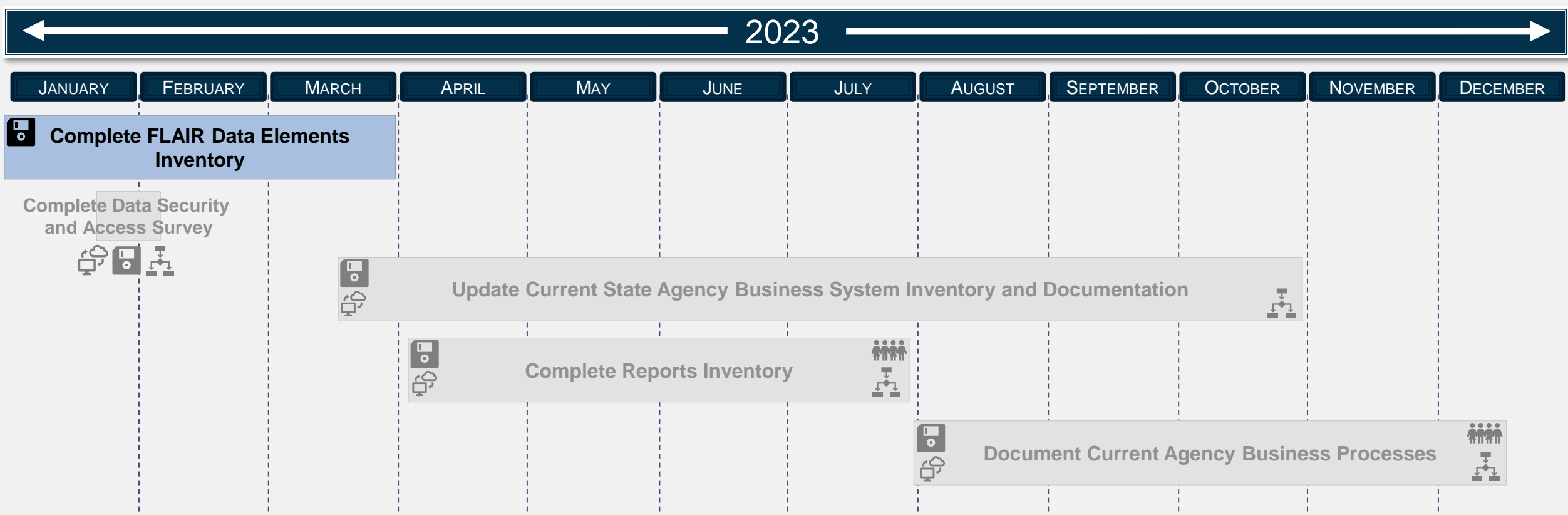
RW Tasks Overview

- ▶ The current state analysis activities are meant to support an agency's readiness journey by enhancing:
 - Agency staff and management's knowledge and understanding of current practices
 - Decision making about business system remediation and process changes
 - Documentation that supports scope of effort and resource requirements
- ▶ The multi-part analysis includes tasks to review, consider, and document the agency's critical data elements, reports, business systems, and business processes

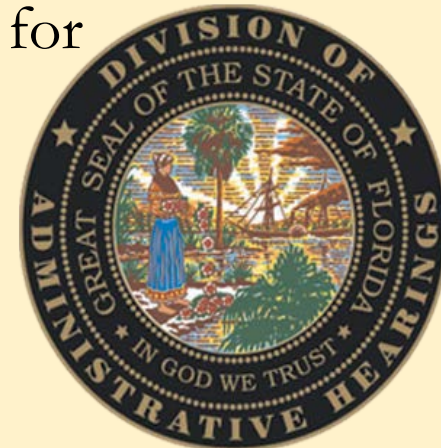

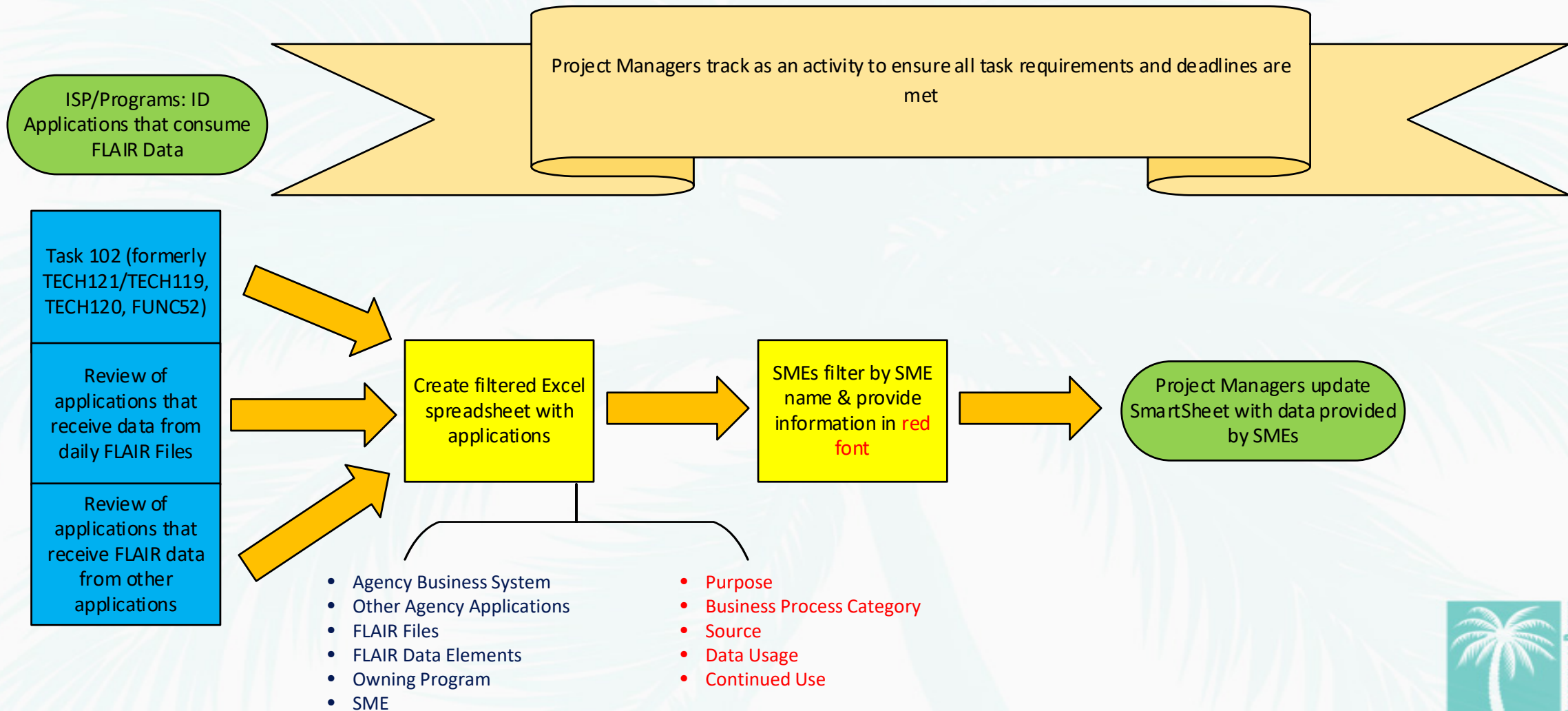

~Florida PALM / FLAIR Data Elements Inventory Approach~

- ❖ Identify all Accounting Tasks/Activities associated with a FLAIR Data Element
- ❖ Meet with Accounting Task/Activity Owners & Accounting Back-up Owners and Programmatic Leads to review each associated FLAIR data element
- ❖ Document Discussions with Accounting Task/Activity Owners, Accounting Back-up Owners & Programmatic Leads
- ❖ Send out the FLAIR Data Elements Inventory to Meeting Participants for Verification prior to submitting the task to Florida PALM

- ▶ Understand how data within the data group is used
- ▶ Identify opportunities for standardization
- ▶ Develop policy where needed
- ▶ Provide guidance as to data cleansing efforts
- ▶ Work toward data conversions with Florida PALM



Data Management and Cleanup

What Can Agencies Do?

- ▶ Complete Task 324
- ▶ Review FLAIR Subsidiary and Expansion Records regularly
- ▶ Review the Master Balance File Records regularly
- ▶ Properly close out Grants, Contracts and Projects, as needed
- ▶ Work towards data clean-up, where possible
- ▶ Document areas that cannot be cleansed, if any

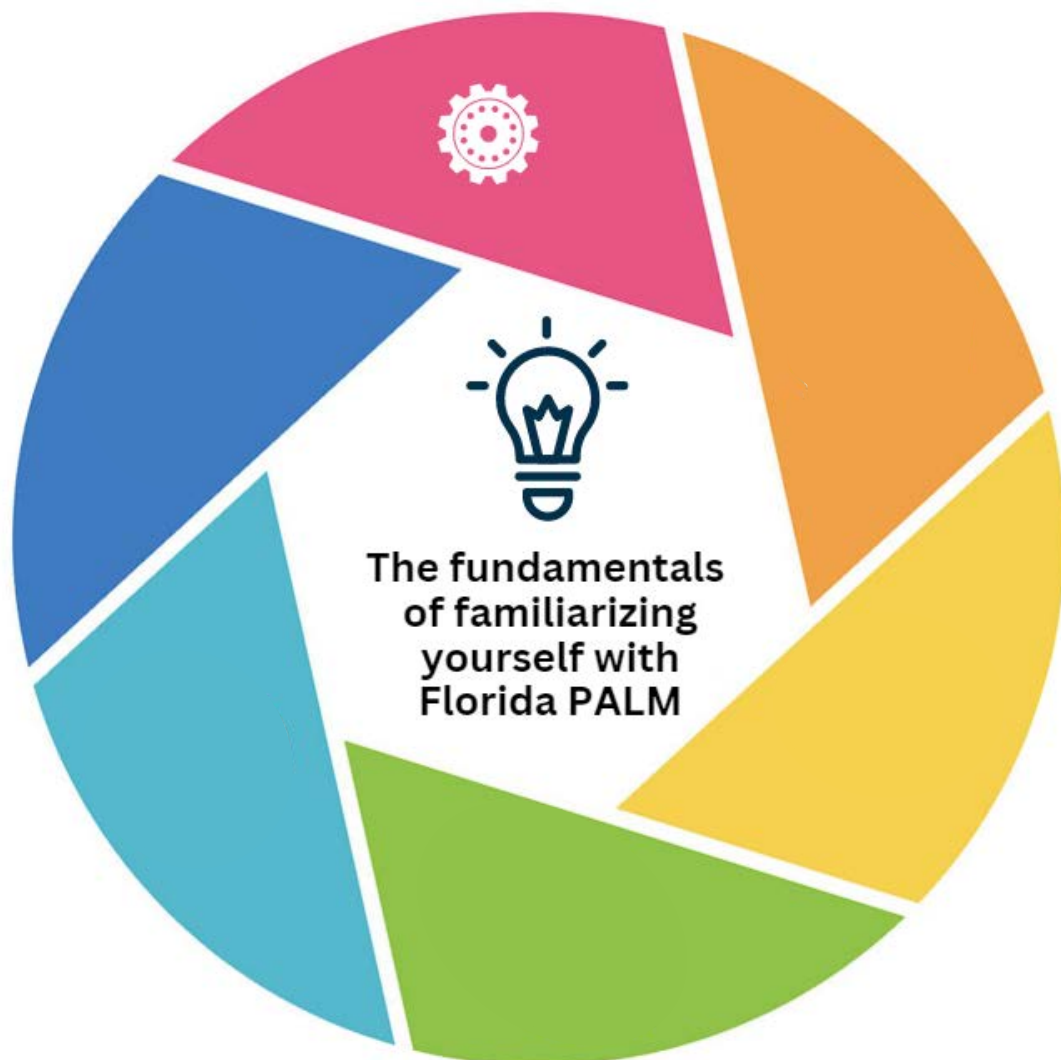

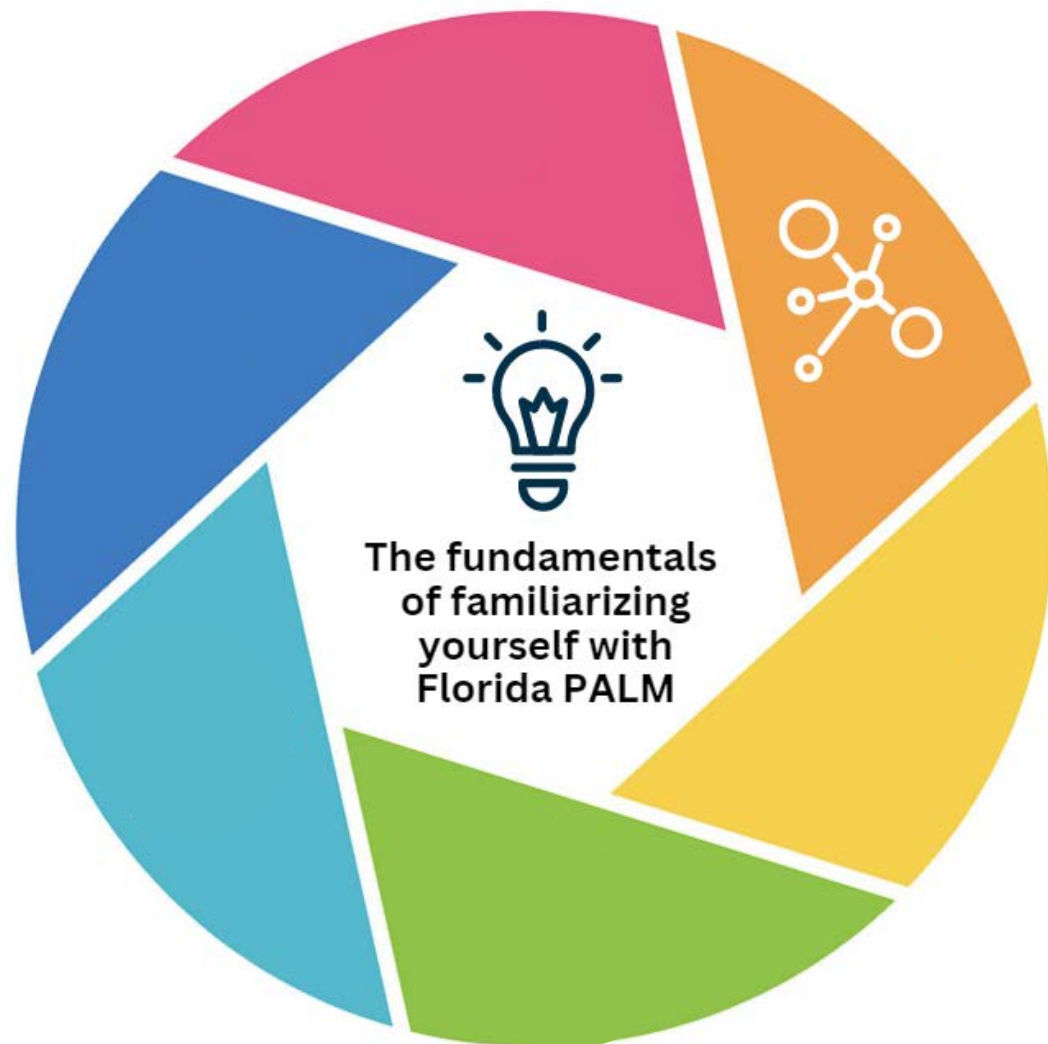


- ▶ Florida PALM is an all-encompassing system that incorporates all activities performed today, into one system, tomorrow

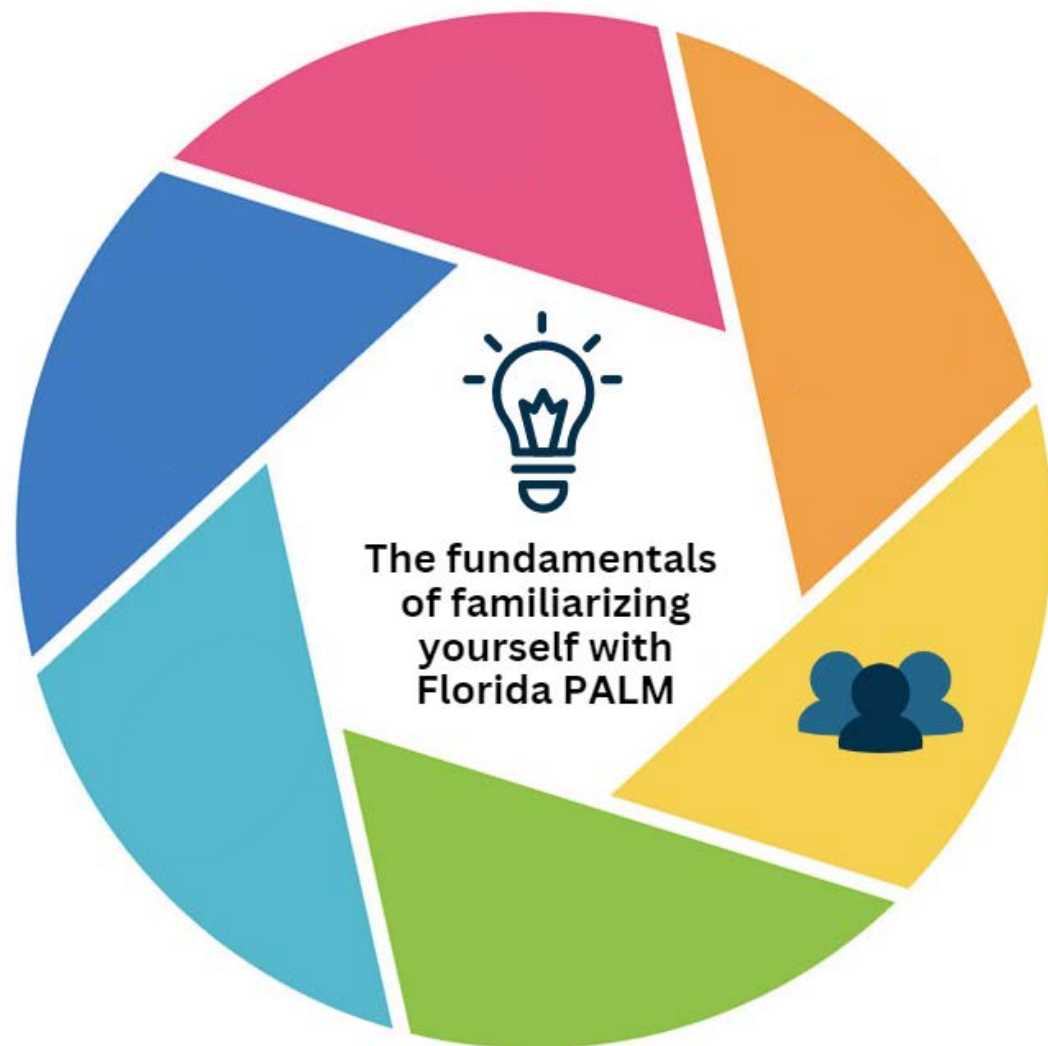
Did You Know?



- ▶ Florida PALM is a single system with multiple modules
 - Modules speak to each other
 - Activity begins in a module and may work its way to the General Ledger Module

- ▶ Everyone works within the same system
 - Agency and Enterprise user access
 - One book of record
- ▶ Business Unit (BU) specific
 - Enterprise BUs
 - Agency BUs

Did You Know?

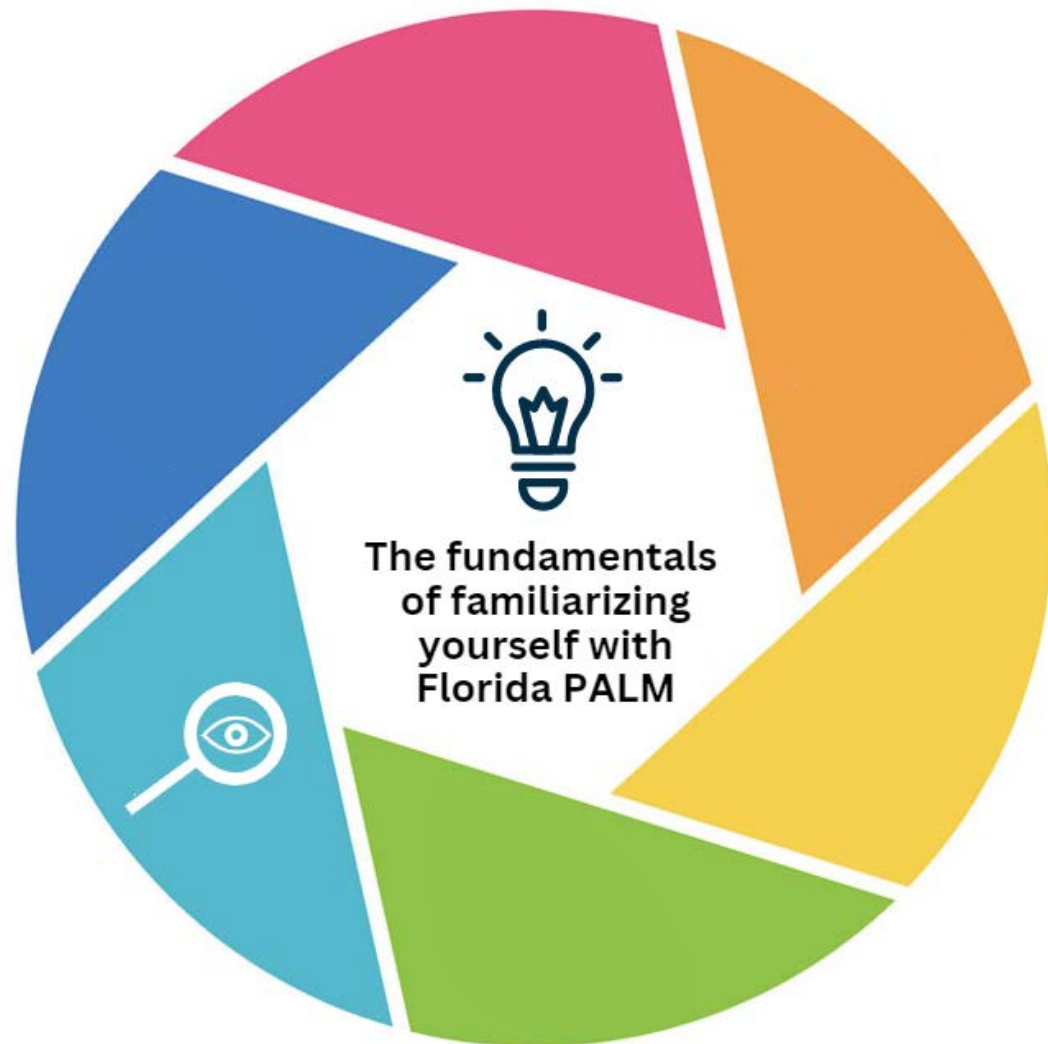


- ▶ Role-based access
 - Grants a user access to functions needed to perform assigned job duties
 - May be assigned multiple roles
 - Single sign on

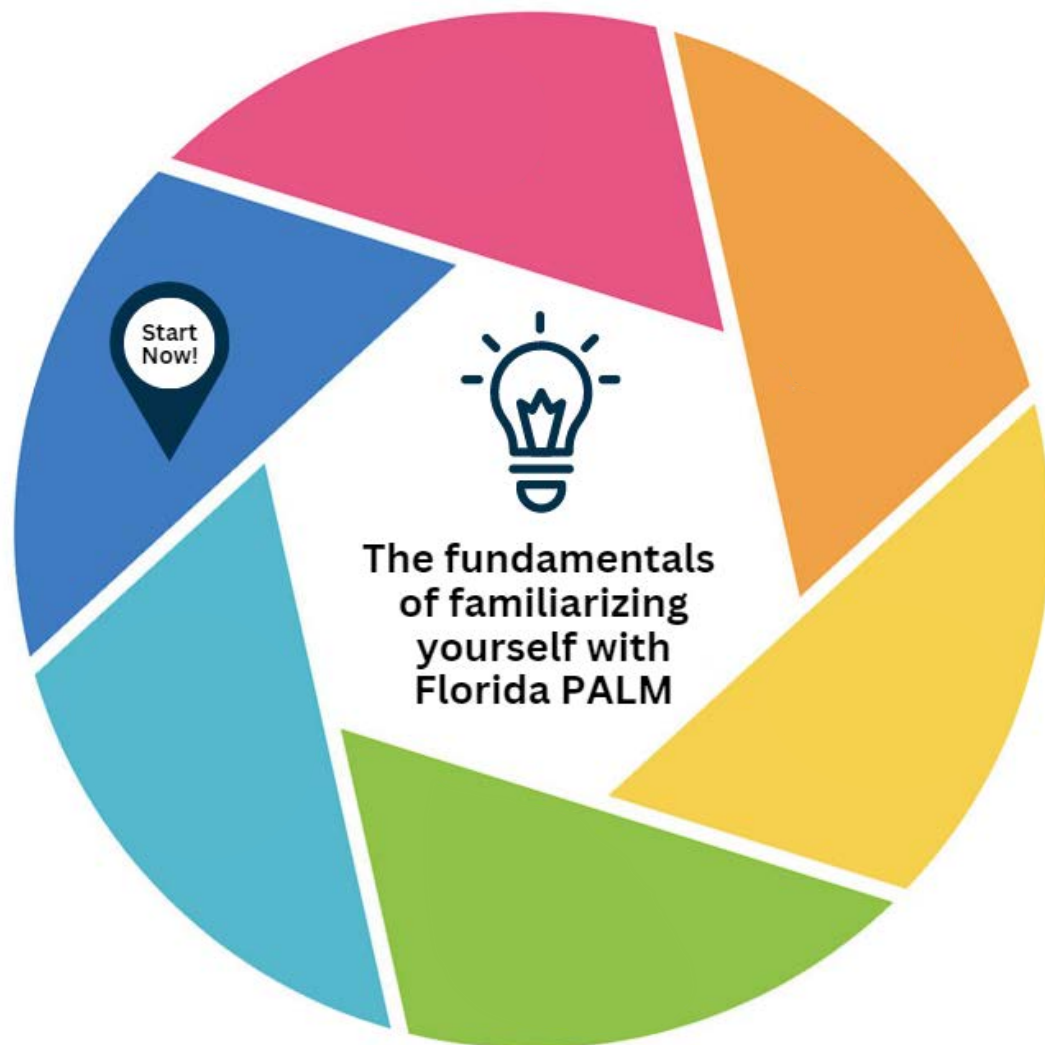

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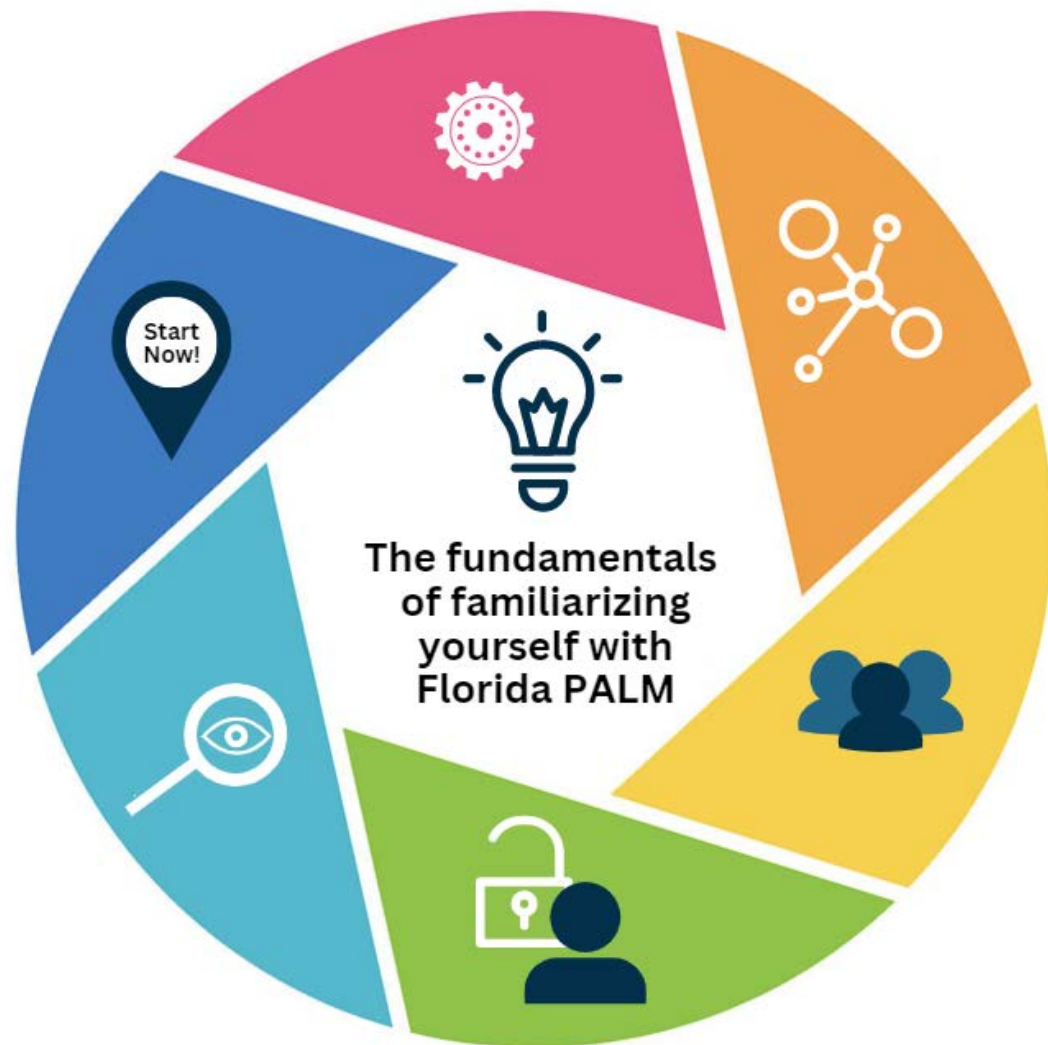
