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Agency Role Mapping Handbook Overview

The Agency Role Mapping Handbook describes and documents the Florida PALM Solution (Florida PALM) roles for the Cash Management System (CMS) Wave. The Role Mapping Handbook is designed to assist agencies in maintenance of role assignments.

Using the Agency Role Mapping Handbook

The Role Mapping Handbook should be used by agencies to assist in your role mapping activities for the CMS Wave. The Florida PALM Project Team suggests agencies follow the steps below to complete your role mapping activities:

1. Review and become familiar with the roles in the Role Mapping Handbook and identify which roles your agency needs to map end users to.
 - a. All agencies should review and be familiar with the *All Agency End User Roles* section
 - b. Florida Department of Commerce (COM) should also review and be familiar with the *COM End User Roles* section
 - c. Department of Revenue (DOR) should also review and be familiar with the *DOR End User Roles* section
 - d. Legislature (LEG) should also review and be familiar with the *LEG End User Roles* section
 - e. Department of Financial Services (DFS) should also review and be familiar with the *DFS End User Roles* section
2. For each CMS Wave end user within your agency, consider the actions they perform today and the actions they will perform within Florida PALM.
3. Determine the Florida PALM role(s) that appropriately align with the actions each end user will perform within Florida PALM.
4. Once the Florida PALM role(s) have been identified, discuss with your agency Security Access Manager (SAM) to assign the appropriate roles for each end user.

There are a few considerations when identifying what roles each CMS Wave end user should be assigned:

- System Enforced Controls – The system prevents an end user from approving a transaction they created regardless of the roles assigned to the end user. This information is expanded upon in the System Enforced Controls section.
- Separation of Duty Conflicts - Certain end user roles should not be assigned with other roles. This information is documented in the Separation of Duties columns in the End User Role tables and expanded upon in the Separation of Duties section.
- Access to multiple business units - A select number of end users can be assigned multiple business units. The business units will apply to any roles the end user is assigned.

Florida PALM Roles

In the CMS Wave, there are five main types of Florida PALM end user roles. Each type of role has primary responsibilities within each Florida PALM module:

1. Maintainer - an administrative role that manages exceptions, ChartField values, or other configuration data. A Maintainer role also has access to run and review reports for the related business processes;

2. Processor - adds, reviews, and updates transactions. A Processor role will typically send transactions to be approved to the approver role. A Processor role also has access to run and review reports for the related business processes;
3. Approver - approves transactions added or updated by a Processor role. An Approver role also has access to run and review reports for the related business processes;
4. Reporter - runs and reviews reports; and
5. Requester - submits support requests (usually through Florida PALM forms) to other end users.

All Agency End User Roles

System Enforced Controls

Florida PALM has system rules to prevent an end user from approving a transaction they created, regardless of the roles assigned to the end user. For example, an end user assigned both the Agency GL Journal Processor and the Agency GL Journal Approver has the ability to create a journal and approve a journal. However, they cannot approve a journal they entered. The system enforced controls apply to:

- Deposits
- Journals
- Cash Transfers
- Forms




SOD Conflict Reasoning

Separation of duties (SOD) identifies which roles must not be assigned to the same end user. These rules are put in place to avoid mapping an end user to roles that cause regulatory, internal, or financial control issues with a single position. For example, the end user who is assigned the DFS Bank Reconciliation Processor role must not also be assigned the DFS Deposit Processor role because it would cause a control issue if the same end user resolved reconciliation issues for the deposits they created. CMS Wave end user roles that must not be assigned to the same CMS Wave end user are documented in the Separation of Duties columns in Tables 1-5.

If an agency has identified a SOD conflict that cannot be resolved, the agency must contact the Division of Accounting and Auditing (A&A), prior to access being granted. A&A will review agency justification and compensating controls. A&A will annually reevaluate SOD conflict requests. If a SOD conflict is not justified and is not approved, then A&A will notify the agency and provide guidance on resolving the SOD conflict.

The reasoning for each SOD conflict identified in the Florida PALM roles section are documented in Table 6.

Workflow

Workflow is the defined process of routing transactions between two or more end user roles in Florida PALM to obtain approval. Multiple end users can be assigned to the same end user role, which may mean they have shared responsibilities in a workflow process. For the CMS Wave, there are three transaction workflows: Cash Transfer Approval, DFS Deposit Approval, GL Journal Approval. During the CMS Wave, agency workflow will be contained within a Business Unit.

Cash Transfer Approval

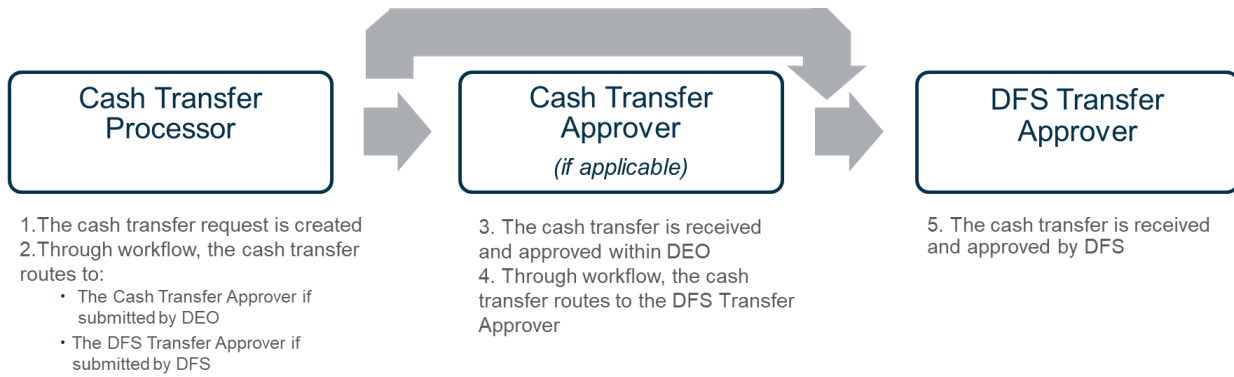


Figure 1: Cash Transfer Approval Workflow Steps

Workflow occurs between the Cash Transfer Processor role (assigned to an end user within the COM Business Unit or an end user within the DFS Business Unit), the Cash Transfer Approver role (assigned to an end user within the COM Business Unit), and the DFS Transfer Approver role (assigned to an end user within the DFS Business Unit). The process steps for this workflow are documented in Figure 1.

DFS Deposit Approval

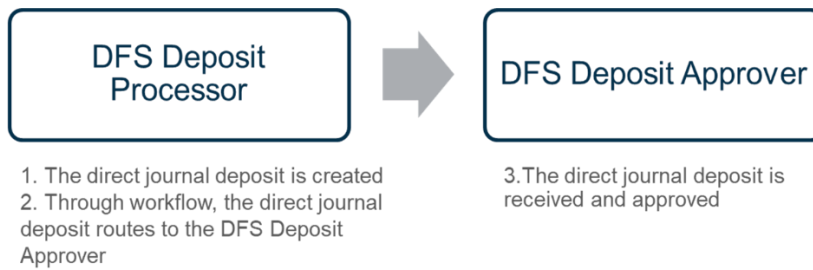


Figure 2: DFS Deposit Approval Workflow Steps

Workflow occurs between the DFS Deposit Processor role and the DFS Deposit Approver role. The process steps for this workflow are documented in Figure 2.

GL Journal Approval

Workflow occurs between the Agency GL Journal Processor role (assigned to an end user within an agency Business Unit), the Agency GL Journal Approver role (assigned to an end user within an agency Business Unit), and the DFS Investment Journal Approver role (assigned to an end user within the DFS Business Unit). The process steps for this workflow are documented in Figure 3.
