Ms Thom pson responded Johnell Caver Your Home for Funerals.

Mr. Helm stated that the application does not reflect this

Ms Marragreed. Ms Marr questioned who was speaking for the applicant

Mr. Johnell Caver, Sr. responded.

Ms Marrquestioned underwhatname is the applicant applying.

Mr. Caverresponded Johnell Caver Your Home for Funerals, Inc.

Ms Marrstated that this is not how the applicant applied. Ms Marrquestioned whether Mr. Chairman would allow the applicant to resubmit a corrected application.

Mr. Chairman stated that the application needs to be resubmitted with the correct name. The Department needs something in writing reflecting exactly what the name should be so that this is reflected on the establishment license.

Mr. Helm stated that Johnell Caver Your Home for Funerals is listed on the Articles of Incorporation, but it is not listed on the application.

Mr. Chairman requested that the applicant submit the appropriate page indicating the correct name of the establishment.

Mr. Cavernesponded yes

MOTION: Ms Zippaymoved to approve the application contingent upon receipt of documentation showing the correct name of the establishment. Col. Ballas seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

DISCUSSION: Ms Hugginsstated that Mr. Caverislisted as FDIC, but his address is in Detroit, Michigan.

Ms Marrquestioned whether Mr. Caverisrelocating to Florida.

Mr. Caver stated that he has already located to Florida and is using the Detroit address as his mailing address. Mr. Caver has lived in Florida for the past 12 years

Mr. Chairman questioned how Mr. Caverwould receive hismail in Michigan.

Mr. Caver stated that he also has a funeral home in Detroit, Michigan.

Mr. Chairman questioned whether Mr. Caverisgoing to be the FDIC of this location and not the one in Michigan.

Mr. Caverresponded yes Mr. Caverstated that he has a manager that has run the Detroit operation for the past year.

3. Stone Brothers Funeral Chapel (Vero Beach)

Ms Marr stated that the application was submitted on July 5, 2007. The application was not complete and a deficiency letter was needed. The fingerprint card for Alwyn L. Gaines was submitted and returned without criminal history. The funeral establishment passed its inspection on 0 ctober 10, 2007.

Mr. Jones questioned whether the Department received a letter of a greement for embalmings

Mr. Helm added that the applicantalso listed that arrangements for preproom would be handled by license #148 This appears to be a licensee, but the applicant should have included the business name.

Mr. Chairman questioned whether the Department had a response.

Ms Marrresponded no, but Staff would look into it.

MOTION: Mr. Jones moved to approve the application subject to receipt of a letter of agreement. Col. Ballasseconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

DISCUSSION: Ms Thomas-DeWittstated that the 317 address is actually the applicant's establishment in Ft Pierce.
