PLAN

- Review your insurance policy and other applicable insurance resources.

PREPARE

- Inventory your home using video and photos.
- Log important insurance contacts including your agent and claims reporting website/phone number.
- · Take mitigation steps tie down or bring in loose objects, trim trees, etc.

PROTECT

- Take steps to **protect your home** from further damage following a storm and to secure it from theft or vandalism.
- Protect your personal information and finances against fraudsters and scammers looking to profit from a vulnerable situation.

- Protect your rights as an insurance consumer by ensuring you understand any documents you sign.
- **Be cautious** of third-parties encouraging you to sign over your insurance rights or to waive your insurance deductible.
