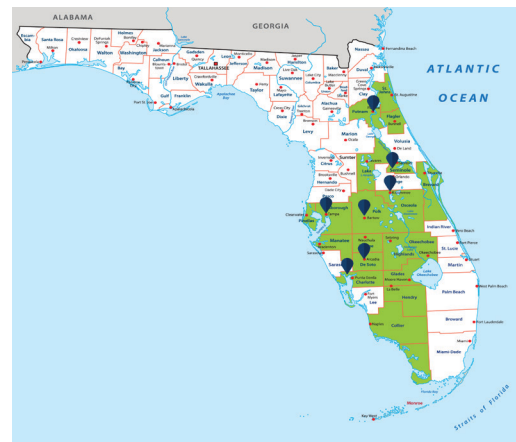
Rebuild Florida Hurricane Ian Recovery Programs

FloridaCommerce announced the availability of additional funding through Rebuild Florida programs to assist the most vulnerable Floridians in the most-impacted Hurricane Ian communities.

Eligible counties include:

Brevard, Charlotte, Collier, DeSoto, Flagler, Glades, Hardee, Hendry, Highlands, Hillsborough, Lake, Manatee, Monroe, Okeechobee, Osceola, Pinellas, Polk, Putnam, Seminole, and St. Johns.

Rebuild Florida Housing Repair and Replacement Program for Hurricane Ian Recovery

There is \$542 million available through the **Rebuild Florida Housing Repair and Replacement Program for Hurricane Ian Recovery (HRRP)** to repair or replace Hurricane Ian-damaged homes, including mobile homes. Households with one or more of the characteristics identified below will be prioritized and processed in the order that they completed an application.

- Households with low to moderate income
- Households with seniors aged 62 and above
- Households with children under the age of 18
- Households with special needs or special accommodation requirements

Eligible individuals are encouraged to apply for the program by visiting lan.RebuildFlorida.gov.

Rebuild Florida Housing Hurricane Ian Multiple Impact Program

There is \$120 million allocated for the **Rebuild Florida Hurricane Ian Multiple Impact Program (MIP)** to assist vulnerable homeowners who have suffered damage from both Hurricane Irma and Hurricane Ian. At-risk and vulnerable populations with the greatest needs will be prioritized.
