- Solar powered phone charger

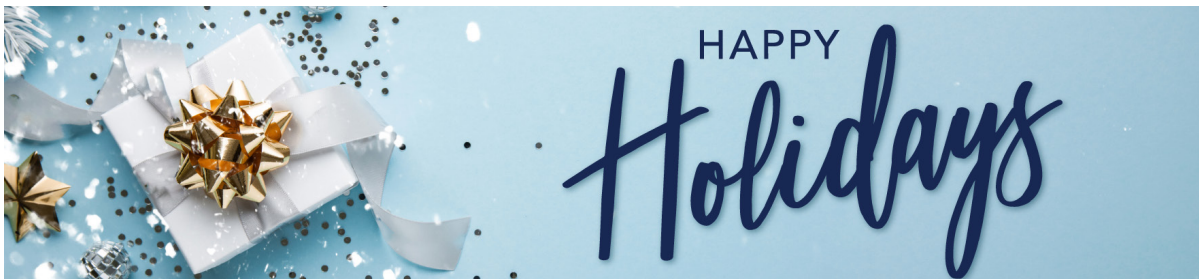
Or give the gift of identity theft prevention and protection:
