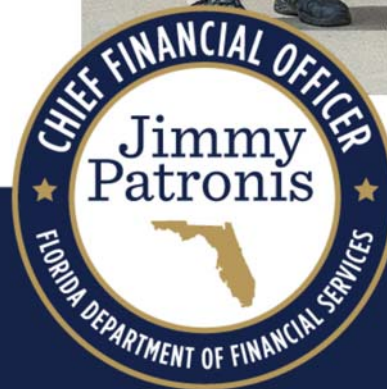

DIFS is pleased to announce that K9 Shay-Ley has joined the Bureau of Fire, Arson and Explosives Investigations in the Northeast Region, Jacksonville Field Office as an Accelerant Detection Canine (ADC).

ADC Shay-Ley and Detective Matt Huffman entered the Accelerant Detection Canine program in April of 2019. Detective Huffman and Shay-Ley completed their certification as a team with Maine Specialty Dogs, on April 26th, after training together for four weeks in Concord, New Hampshire. Shay-Ley is constantly maintained by Detective Huffman and stays at home with him when not on duty. Together as a team, they train constantly to maintain Shay-Ley's proficiency in accelerant detection.

The Division now has a total of eight specialized canine teams serving the state of Florida.
