During his time at UFPD he worked in the uniformed patrol division, served as bike patrol officer, field training officer, DUI investigation instructor, and participated in the university's Student Community-Oriented Policing Effort.

In 2014 Lieutenant Craven joined the Division of Investigative and Forensic Services as a detective with the Bureau of Insurance Fraud, working primarily in South Florida. In 2016 he took a short hiatus from DIFS and accepted a position as a United States Probation Officer for the Middle District of Georgia.
