Lieutenant Gonzalez began his law enforcement career in 1987 with the Madeira Beach Police Department before moving on to the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office later that same year. While at the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office, Lieutenant Gonzalez served in various functions, to include: Uniform Patrol, SWAT and Narcotics Task Force Detective.

Lieutenant Gonzalez remained at the Pinellas County Sheriff's office until accepting employment with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) in May 1996. During his tenure with the DEA, Lieutenant Gonzalez served as a Special Agent and Special Agent Supervisor in 4 different domestic posts and 5 different foreign posts in South America.
