In January 2009, she was promoted to Lieutenant of the newly formed West Palm Beach PIP Squad.

In her tenure with the Division, Evangelina has been involved in the successful prosecution of many major cases. In 2014, she and her squad were featured on the A&E television program, American Takedown, which went behind the scenes to follow the takedown of one of America's most prominent PIP fraud rings.
