Detective Jonathan Renfroe is retiring after 30years of service with the State of Florida.

Prior to his state employment, Jonathan served as a Warehouse Manager for 7 years. In March of 1990 he joined the Florida Lottery as a Commodities Distributor and as a Marketing Specialist starting in 1995.

In July of 1996 Jonathan became a Corrections Officer with the Dade Correctional Institution, promoting to Sergeant in 1999. Jonathan then worked for the Florida State University Police Department before accepting a Youth Custody Officer position with the Department of Juvenile Justice in 2002.

Jonathan joined the Division of Investigative & Forensic Services, Bureau of Insurance Fraud (BIF) in 2010 as a Detective at the Miami Field Office. In January 2017 Jonathan transferred to the Bureau of Fire, Arson & Explosives Investigations (BFAEI), and returned to BIF in June of 2018 where he remained until his retirement.
