JR Thompson is retiring after 45 years in law enforcement. Thompson began his law enforcement career with the St. Petersburg Police Department in July of 1973. During his time with the Department he held a wide variety of positions. He began as a Patrol Officer, soon transitioned to the Detective Division, and later returned to the Patrol Division as a Sergeant. He also worked as a supervisor in the Forensics Section for a number of years. Thompson ultimately rose to the rank of Major over the Internal Affairs Division, from which he retired in June of 2010 with 38 years of service.

Thompson joined the Division of Investigative and Forensic Services in September of 2011 and was assigned to the General Fraud Squad in the St. Petersburg Field Office. During his time with the Division he was instrumental in working a variety of Health Care fraud cases and served as a liaison with other Law Enforcement Agencies.
