Tampa Financial Investigator Brian Brynjolfsson

Brian Brynjolfsson started his career in commercial banks both in the state of Illinois and Florida. Beginning as a teller working his way up to Vice President of the loan department.

In Brian's first job as an Investigator and Department Head of Investigations with the Resolution Trust Corporation (RTC) he investigated the civil and criminal fraud as well as the failures of several savings and loans in New Jersey and Florida. During his tenure with the RTC he worked with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Agents investigating loan losses resulting from kick-backs that were paid to a commercial mortgage loan officer.

Brian worked for 3.5 years with the State of Florida, Department of Revenue before taking a job as a Financial Analyst / Forensic Accountant with the FBI in Tampa. He obtained a considerable amount of experience in financial investigations during his 15.5 years with the Bureau. During that time, he worked on cases involving Health Care, Mortgage and Investment Fraud. As a Forensic Accountant with the FBI he worked with the Division of Investigative and Forensic Services detectives on a large under cover case known as "Misplaced Trust" in Tampa.

After retiring from the FBI, Brian joined the Division of Investigative and Forensic Services as a Financial Investigator, in May of 2016. During his time with the Division, he worked on clinic cases in Tampa, Orlando and West Palm Beach, and Auto Insurance Fraud cases in Tampa, as well as Workers' Compensation fraud cases in Jacksonville and Orlando.

Brian has B.A. in Business Administration from Elmhurst College in Illinois and has been a Certified Fraud Examiner since 2001.
