Tampa BIF Lieutenant Carlos Rosario

Lt. Carlos Rosario began his law enforcement career in July of 1981, when he Joined the NYPD. He served for 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ years. Carlos began as a Patrol Officer, then Applicant Investigator and spent most of his career as an Internal Affairs investigator. He retired from NYPD as a Detective 2^{nd} Grade.

In May of 2003 Carlos joined the Department of Investigative and Forensic Services, Bureau of Insurance Fraud, in the Tampa Field Office. During his time as a detective Carlos was instrumental in the closure of numerous clinics throughout the West Central Region. His successes doing undercover work elevated him to Lead Detective for his squad and eventually promoted to rank of Lieutenant Tampa PIP Squad.

As a Lieutenant, Carlos worked well with his squad, leading the Tampa Field Office to several awards. The Tampa Field Office received The Davis Award in 2009 and The Group Achievement Award at FIFEC in June 2017. Carlos was also nominated for The Jerry Zappalo, Distinguished Achievement Award 2019.

Prior to his Law Enforcement Career, Carlos served in the US Army where he served as a combat engineer. Carlos was honorably discharged in 1977.
