



NFPA Codes and Standards with Jurisdictional Changes – Change Indicator Guide

When viewing NFPA codes and standards with jurisdictional changes in NFPA LiNK, the revision symbols displayed in the margins have a slightly different meaning. Within these jurisdictional codes, you are not viewing changes from edition year to edition year (example: changes from 2020 to 2023). Instead, the symbols are identifying changes from the NFPA version that was released to the version for that city/state/ region (for the same edition year).

As a reminder, revisions symbols indicate the following, and are meant to serve as a guide:

- Revisions to text are **shaded**.
- **Δ** before a section number indicates that words within that section were deleted.
- **Δ** to the left of a table or figure number indicates a revision to an existing table or figure.
- When a chapter was heavily revised, the entire chapter is marked throughout with the symbol **Δ**.
- Where one or more sections were deleted, a **•** is placed between the remaining sections.
- Chapters, annexes, sections, figures, and tables that are new are indicated with an **N**.
