NFIRS Training at the Nation Fire Academy

January 2011 - A 6- day course (R491) was developed which provides in-depth training on managing a NFIRS program.

As of this year, there have been a total of 91 fire departments that have not submitted any incidents. 61 of those departments are volunteer departments, 30 are paid departments. YTD total – 513 fire departments are participating in the FFIRS program.

A hard look is being taken into mutual aid calls to ensure that they are being reported correctly.

<u>Legislation</u> - A re-work is underway within the Department of Health. The Bureau of EMS is confident but expecting some of the smaller offices to be consolidated into the different Bureaus.

The Bureau is still incorporating public safety legislation for dispatchers.

<u>Rule</u> – Instructor Standards for EMS Instructors

Education – 87% pass rate on ALS/BLS Inspections. 100 done YTD, 39 to go.

 $\underline{\text{Grants}}$ – giving out 1.5 – 3 million every year. Pediatric Unit has money available for pediatric training.

<u>EMSTARS</u> – There are currently 2.6 million records in the data base with 120 agencies participating.
