



COVID-19 Vaccine Insurance Coverage Information

As Florida residents begin to receive the COVID-19 vaccine, you may have questions such as, “How much will this vaccine cost?” and “Will my insurance cover costs associated with administering this vaccine?”

It is important to note, the federal government purchased millions of doses of the COVID-19 vaccine to provide to consumers at no cost. You will have access to the vaccine, whether or not you have insurance.

However, the [CDC](#) has indicated, “vaccination providers will be able to charge an administration fee for giving the shot to someone. Vaccine providers can get this fee reimbursed by the patient’s public or private insurance company or, for uninsured patients, by the Health Resources and Services Administration’s Provider Relief Fund.”
