# **Resident Legal Expense Sales Representative**

# TYPE AND CLASS: 2-56 Legal Expense Sales Representative

# Common Use(s) of License:

Florida Statutes 642.015 defines a "LEGAL EXPENSE INSURANCE" as an individual who offers a contractual obligation to provide specific legal services, or to reimburse for specific legal expenses, in consideration of a specified payment for an interval of time, regardless of whether the payment is made by the beneficiaries individually or by a third person for them, but does not include the provisions of, or reimbursement for, legal services incidental to other insurance coverage.

# STEPS TO OBTAIN 2-56 LEGAL EXPENSE SALES REPRESENTATIVE:

Step 1 - You must:

- Be a natural person at least 18 years of age.
- Be a resident of the State of Florida.
- Be a <u>United States citizen or legal alien</u> who possesses a work authorization from the United States Immigration and Naturalization Services.

### Step 2 - Apply:

Answer all of the questions and pay the fees to complete online application.
<u>Review fees</u>
<u>Apply</u>
<u>Fingerprinting fees</u> are not included and must be paid directly to vendor

### Step 3 - Fingerprints:

• You must be <u>fingerprinted</u>.

### **Special Note:**

- If licensed in another state within three years, provide a Letter of Clearance.
- No examination is required.
