9-56 Legal Expense Sales Representative

Common Use(s) of License:

Florida Statutes 642.034 defines a “LEGAL EXPENSE SALES REPRESENTATIVE” as an individual who offers a contractual obligation to provide specific legal services, or to reimburse for specific legal expenses, in consideration of a specified payment for an interval of time, regardless of whether the payment is made by the beneficiaries individually or by a third person for them, but does not include the provisions of, or reimbursement for, legal services incidental to other insurance coverage.

STEPS TO OBTAIN 2-56 LEGAL EXPENSE SALES REPRESENTATIVE:

Step 1 - You must:

- Be a natural person at least 18 years of age.
- Not be a resident of the State of Florida.
- Be a [United States citizen or legal alien](#) who possesses a work authorization from the United States Immigration and Naturalization Services.

Step 2 - Apply:

- Answer all of the questions and pay the fees to complete online application.
